Sanction: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming.
Sanction #IN24105.

Location: East Central Natatorium
East Central High School

Facility: The 40-yard pool consists of eight lanes, with a starting end depth of 7ft feet and the turning end depth of 12 feet, separated by non-turbulent lane markers. Cool down lanes will be available. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.22C(4). Each lane is equipped with Colorado electronic timing system. Digital watches are used as backup. Bleacher spectator seating is provided.

Eligibility: 202.49 E & 205.2.2 & 202.4.9 F – Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of November 10th, 2023 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern this meet.

202.5.3 – At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

202.4.9 D – Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to enter compliance with this requirement.

Coaches MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The Meet Referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming rule 205.101.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

202.4.9 H – Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

202.4.9 I – Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.

202.4.9 J – Operation of a drones, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue) pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

Safe Sport 360:

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after 10/13/22, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after 10/13/22, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

Format: All events will be timed finals, enter in yard times. The number of heats will be determined after receipt of all entries and after reviewing timeline. East Central Swim Team reserves the right to limit entries in any event in order to adhere to the 4-hour rule for age group swimmers. Clubs with swimmers not accepted will be notified. Refunds will be made to all clubs with swimmers not allowed to compete in any limited events. Note: events that will be limited are designated in the schedule of events.

Mixed Gender Events will be utilized to maintain the timeline of the session. These mixed events are designated in the schedule of events. All 1000 Swimmers will be required to provide their own timer and counter for the event.

Entries: Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events per Friday and Saturday session, plus relays. Please submit entry file using Hy-Tek's Team Manager through email to bsloveless@sunmandearborn.k12.in.us.

- Deadline:** Entries will be accepted starting October 19, 2023. Entry deadline will be November 3, 2023. We will extend the deadline if the meet is not full.
- Fees:** The entry fee for this meet will be \$5.00 per individual event, \$8.00 per relay, and \$10.00 per athlete facility surcharge. Make checks payable to East Central Swim Team. Deck entries will be accepted if the meet is not full and at the discretion of the Entry Chair. Fees for on-deck entries will be \$10.00 per individual event.
- Refunds:** In any meet sanctioned by Indiana Swimming other than Championship Meets, the host team shall limit the number of swimmers in any one or more events to maintain a reasonable length of the meet. In the event that entries are limited, the host club must return the entry fees to the club(s) whose swimmers are not allowed to compete in the specific event(s).
- IF A SWIMMER SCRATCHES AN EVENT OR THE ENTIRE MEET, WE CANNOT SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER SWIMMER IN HIS/HER PLACE. THIS WILL BE CONSIDERED A NEW ENTRY AND WILL BE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY.
- Check-In:** **ALL SWIMMERS MUST CHECK IN PRIOR TO WARM-UPS!** Check in sheets will be given to coaches and collected or turned in within 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Swimmers who fail to check in will be scratched.
- Clerk of Course:** A clerk of course will be conducted for 8 & Under swimmers ONLY, who must report to the clerk of course when the event is called. ALL other swimmers will report directly to the blocks. We will conduct a one-way direction to enter/exit the blocks. Lane assignments will be posted and given to coaches.
- Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for places 1st – 12th in individual events. For scoring purposes, all Friday night events and Saturday 8 & Under will be score 6U, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, and 13 & over will be scored separately.
- Admission: & Heat Sheets:** Admissions is included in the meet surcharge, and there will be no charge at the door. Heat sheets are available on Meet Mobile for free and will be available for \$2.00 to purchase.
- Concessions:** Concession stand will be sold in the hallway outside the main entrance to the pool.
