This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming.

South Dearborn High School is located on SR 350 just west of West US 50 in Aurora, approximately 25 miles west of Cincinnati and 90 miles southeast of Indianapolis.

Facility

The 25-yard pool consists of six lanes, with a starting end depth of 10 feet and turning end depth of 3 feet, 6 inches, separated by non-turbulent lane markers. A Daktronics timing system with horn start, touch pads, and a Daktronics scoreboard will be used. Spectator seating will be available in the pool area. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C4).

Eligibility

Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of Nov. 8, 2020 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet. Indiana Swimming does not process onsite memberships.

Rules

Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.

Safe Sport 360: The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable
Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes
which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult.
Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for Safe Sport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after October 10, 2020, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after October 10, 2020, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

- At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in arranging for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA
 Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must
 start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a
 member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal
 quardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.
- Coaches and Officials MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The meet referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if a coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current. In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men,the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Format

- All events will be timed finals
- Entries will be limited to 1200 swims per day and/or the four-hour session length. In the event that entries are limited, we will refund entries not accepted.
- On deck entries will NOT be accepted.

Scoring

- Scoring for twelve (12) places will be used.
- We will use breakout scoring by age groups.
- Open events will use breakout scoring for 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 and over.
- All 12 and under events will use breakout scoring for 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, and 11-12 age groups.
- All 10 and under events will use breakout scoring for 9-10, 7-8, and 6 and under.
- All 8 and under events will score 6 and under and 7-8.

Awards

- Individual- strip ribbons for 1st to 6th.
- Individual High Point awards will be given to one boy and one girl in each age group, consisting of 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 and over.

Entries Deadline

Entries will be accepted starting Oct. 9, 2020 and will close on **November 1, 2020**. The deadline will be extended if the meet is not full.

Check-in

<u>ALL SWIMMERS MUST CHECK-IN BEFORE WARM-UPS</u>. Check-in sheets will be taken down 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Swimmers who fail to check-in will be scratched.

Results

Each team will receive an electronic copy of the final results.

Concession

Refreshments will be available throughout the meet. There will be a hospitality room available for coaches and officials in the conference room overlooking the pool.

Team Area

There will be a designated team area for each team on deck. We ask that you cooperate in keeping your swimmers under control and in cleaning up your area after each session. **Camping is not allowed in the viewing stands.**

Parking is available in the west high school parking lot, the middle school lower lot, and the upper lot near the main entrance. Enter at the doors marked MAIN ENTRANCE at the top of the steps at the front of the school.
